Hints to Cotton Planters. An exchange publishes the following suggestions to cotton planters, which will soon be timely, and, if observed, will prove valuable to those preparing their crop for market.

1. Heavy bales are more economical to the shipper than light ones, on account of freight, drayage, &c. 2. Put up no bales weighing less than 300 pounds net, as by trade regulations bales under that weight are unmerchantable.

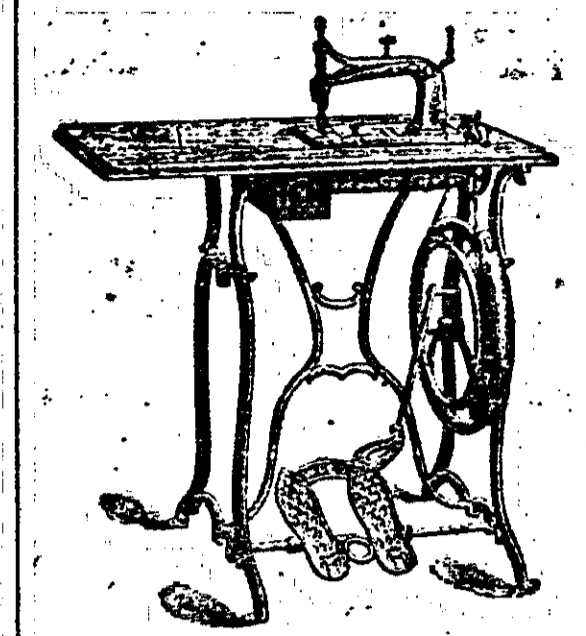

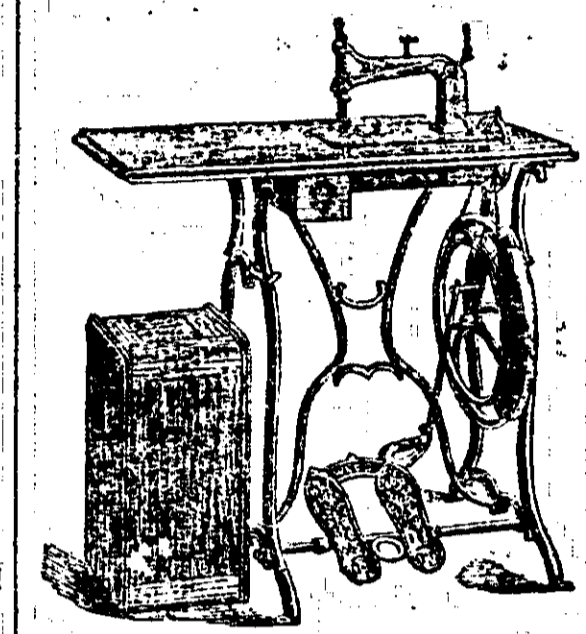

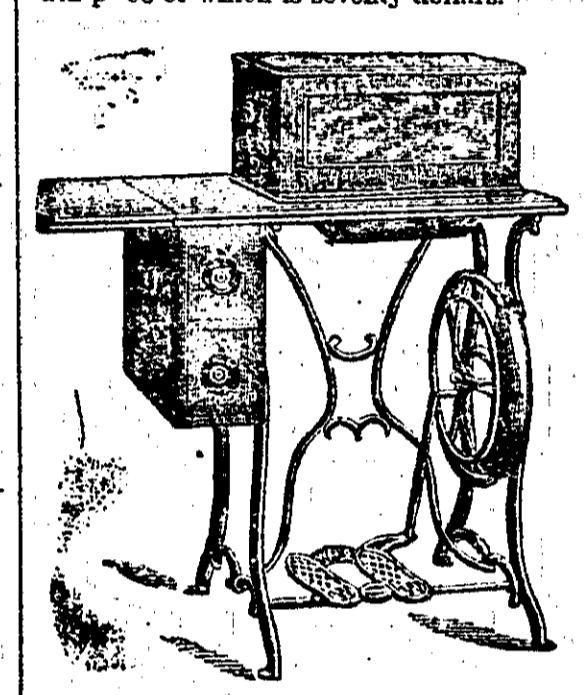
